

Further, the Hon'ble High Court while hearing another petition bearing CWP No. 16074 of 2024 on 10.03.2025 directed that no written statement /pleadings will be accepted in the Court in any case on the date of hearing. 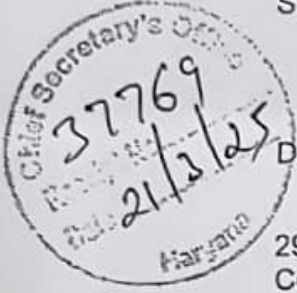

Dear Shri Anurag Rastogi ji

It is being brought to your notice that during the hearing of CWP No. 29441 of 2023 -Manoj Rathee Vs. Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court and others on 05.08.2024, the Division Bench of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, Punjab and Haryana High Court was pleased to order that the Members of the Bar appearing on behalf of the respondents should ensure filing of their replies at least three days prior to the date of hearing with an advance copy to the other side.

Thereafter, even during the hearing of CWP No. 16074 of 2024-Mata Gejwanti Education Society and another Vs. CBSE and others on 10.03.2025, the Division Bench of Hon'ble the Chief Justice was pleased to order that in continuation of the order dated 05.08.2024, as referred to above, Registry of the Hon'ble High Court was directed to make a note in the daily cause list informing all the Members of the Bar that no written statement/ pleadings will be accepted in Court in any case fixed on the date of hearing and in case the written statement/ pleadings are filed on the date of listing of the case, the same may be accepted by imposing appropriate costs. Now, the said writ petition is posted for hearing on 03.04.2025. For ready reference, both the orders, as referred to above, are enclosed herewith.

In compliance of the orders passed by the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, even a note has been displayed in the daily cause list being issued by the Punjab and Haryana High Court, a photocopy of which is also enclosed herewith.

In view of the above, you are requested to issue necessary instructions to all concerned that the replies/ pleadings on behalf of all the Government Department and its instrumentalities be necessarily filed at least three days in advance before the date fixed so as to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in letter and spirit. It may be treated as most urgent as the matter will be taken for further hearing on 03.04.2025 only.
